# Republic Day Celebration

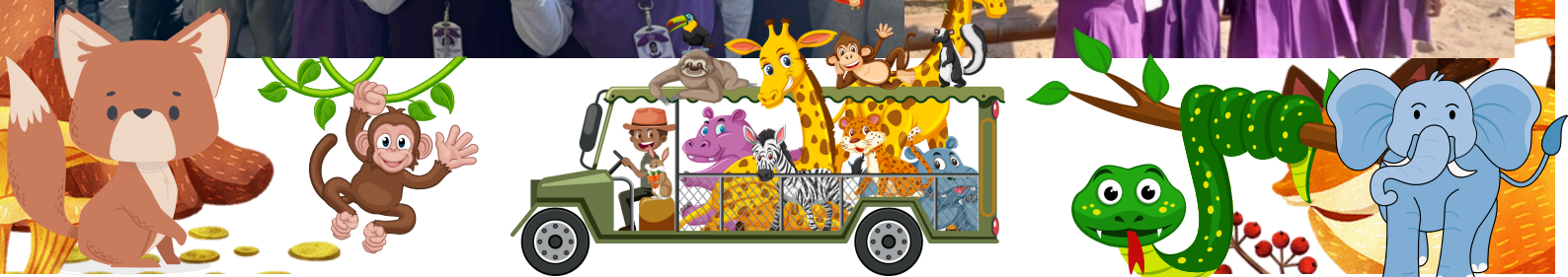
