### **First Term: Rhythm & Reading**

#### **10. April: The Beat Returns**

- **Focus:** Reviewing steady beat vs. rhythm. Introduction of "The Conductor" (starting/stopping on cue).

#### **11. May: Ta**

- **Focus:** Introduction of Quarter Notes (Ta).

#### **12. July: The Sound of Silence**

- **Focus:** Introducing the Quarter Rest. Playing "Don't Play on the Rest" elimination games.

#### **13. August: Rhythm Patterns**

- **Focus:** Composing 4-beat "sentences" using flashcards. Performing rhythms.
