Round-1 * CURRENT AFFAIRS

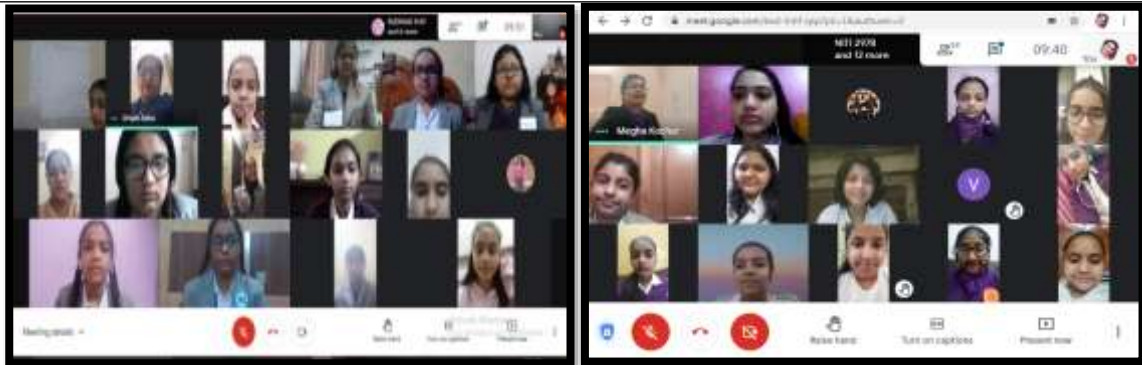
Round-2 * EMINENT BOOKS AND AUTHORS (LITERATURE)

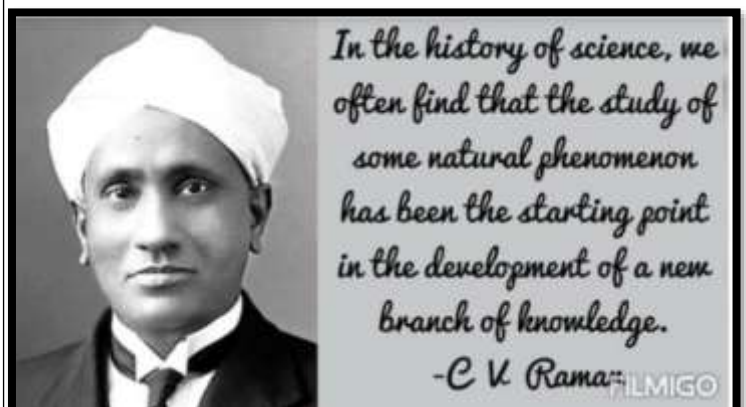
