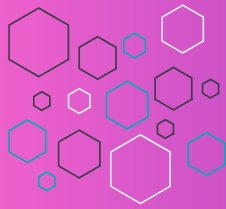

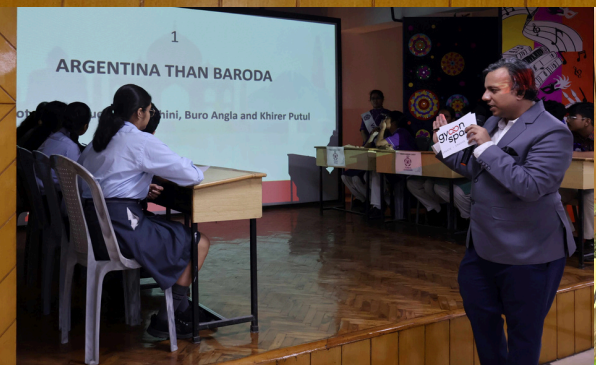
Each school participated with great enthusiasm, bringing their best talent forward. Among the competing institutions, **Goodley Public School emerged as the overall champion**.
