During Book Week celebration in school, Scholastic Book Fair was put up in the school premises wherein students and parents browsed the latest collection. Various activities were also conducted during this time.

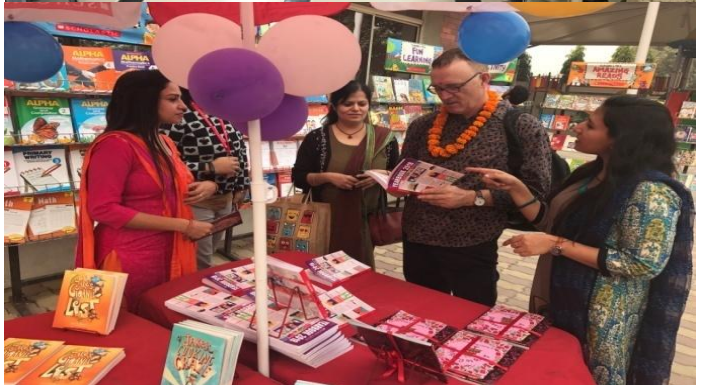

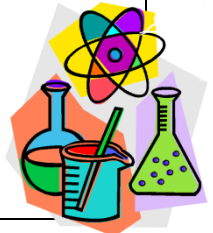
