Course on Experiential Learning and Competency based Education by CBSE on Diksha Platform

MODULE 1: The training focused on the understanding of CBE, difference between traditional and CBE system of education and benefits of CBE. CBE clearly defines the learning outcomes. It follows a flexible time frame where multiple pedagogies are followed. CBE has variety of engaging content both for the educators and the students which has a great impact as it enhances the teacher learner interaction and gives flexibility to use various strategies. CBE system of education is very beneficial as it encourages lifelong learning, it encourages the pupils to take ownership of their learning, gives flexibility to the educators to make decisions for the best of the students. CBE supports lifelong learning and provides empowerment to the students. The pedagogical principles are designed to meet the actual learning needs of the students.

MODULE 2: This module emphasized on the Quality Design Principles for CBE which includes three major pillars – Purpose and Culture Design Principles, Teaching and Learning Design Principle and Structure Design Principle. The Purpose and Culture Design Principles of CBE ensures that all the students succeed. It prepares the students for their future roles and fulfills their visions. Its principles work to develop leadership in both the students and the educators through adaptive and distributive leadership. CBE nurtures a culture of learning inclusivity. Teaching and Learning Design Principle focusses on instructional approach based on learning sciences. They develop different academic skills, social and emotional skills and life experiences. It is learner centered, designed to meet the diverse needs of the students. Structure Design Principle is based on three pillars- Alignment Principle, Consistency Principle and Transparency. In the Alignment Principle the instruction, assessment and learning experiences are well aligned. The educators get an opportunity to plan, collaborate and create. Under Consistency the pupil outcomes are evaluated against a reliable and constant criterion. Teachers work collaboratively to help students. In Transparency the learning objectives and assessment criterion are transparent.

MODULE 3: This module emphasized on Teaching Practices in Competency Based Education. It explained the major principles that govern the teaching practices in CBE which include Base Pedagogy on Learning Sciences, Build Student Agency and Ownership, Focus on Development of Higher Order Skills, etc. The three capacities to encourage student agency were discussed in detail highlighting on the three aspects of coaching, meaningful information and opportunities. The role to be played by the teacher in CBE were discussed in detail. This module also covered the competencies and skills that the educators need to support student learning in CBE. These include-Knowledge Competencies, Intrapersonal Competencies and Interpersonal Competencies.

MODULE 4: focused on Classroom Management Practices in Competency Based Education. It clearly defines policies, practices and core features in every CBE classroom. The six features explained that the learning targets should be shared with the students and linked across all concepts and skills. Pacing and Progression is another important feature explained. This module also covered learning experiences in CBE which would help in developing understanding of designing classroom curriculum.
