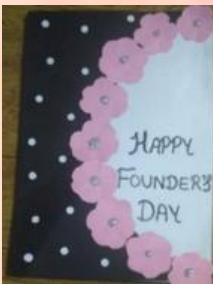

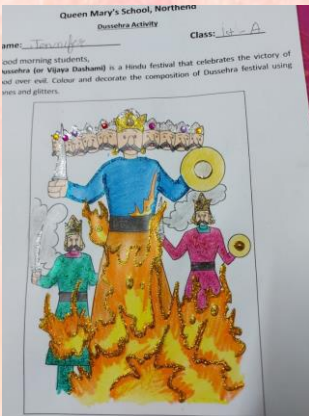

23\10\20: On the occasion of *Dussehra*, various activities were organized and the children actively participated in them.

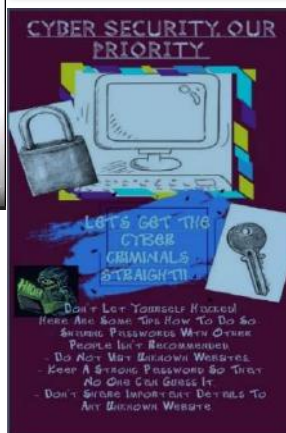
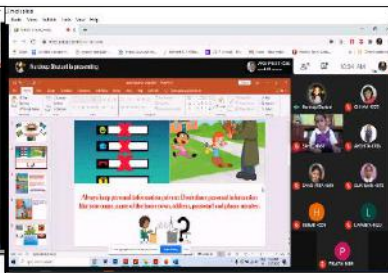
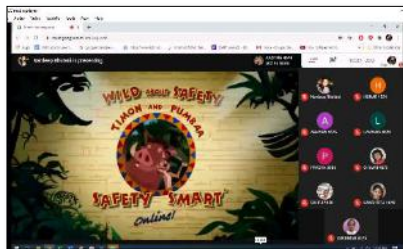

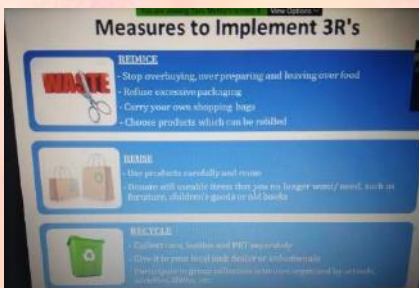
# Activities
