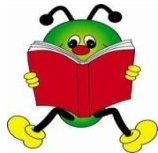
### Activities

## Activities

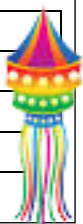

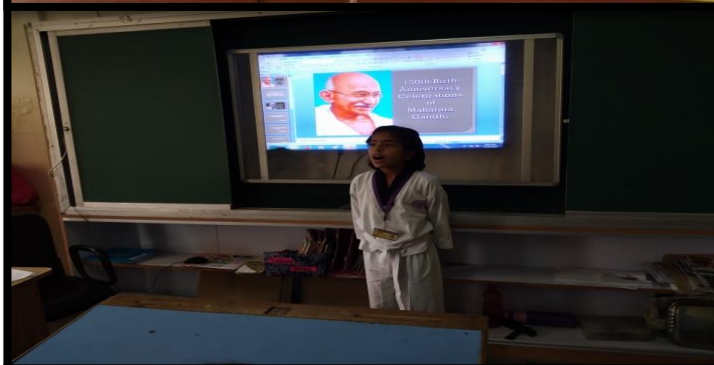
## CBSE CLEANLINESS DRIVE FOR SWACHH BHARAT- SWACHHATA PAKHWADA
