- We use Had when we talk about something that we possessed in the past. Eg: Yesterday, I had fever.

| 1. I, You , We , They | Root form of verb. <br> Eg - eat, walk, go , do |
| 2. He , She , It | Root form + s/es <br> Eg - eats, walks, goes , does |
