## Use of ' $A$ ' or ' $A n$ '

- We use a or an only with singular nouns.
- We use 'á' before a word beginning with a consonant sound.

For example : $\underline{a}$ banana, $\underline{a}$ cat, $\underline{a}$ fruit, $\underline{a}$ bicycle

- We use 'an' before a word beginning with a vowel sound.

For example : an apple, an elephant, an Indian

- We do not use $\underline{\text { a }}$ or an before names of people.

For example : John, Sarah

- We do not use $\underline{\mathbf{a}}$ or an before names of villages, towns, cities or countries.

For example : Delhi, India, Russia

Let's pronounce the following.

- uniform, European, unicorn, useful animal: All these words begin with the phonic sound -yu, which is a consonant sound. Hence, we say ' a uniform, a European, a unicorn, a useful animal'.
- honour, honest, hour : All these words begin with the phonic sound -o, which is a vowel sound. Hence, we say 'It's an honour', 'an honest man', 'an hour' because ' $\mathbf{h}$ ' is silent in these words.
