- 2) Suggesting innovative solutions to the problems faced by the youth of our country

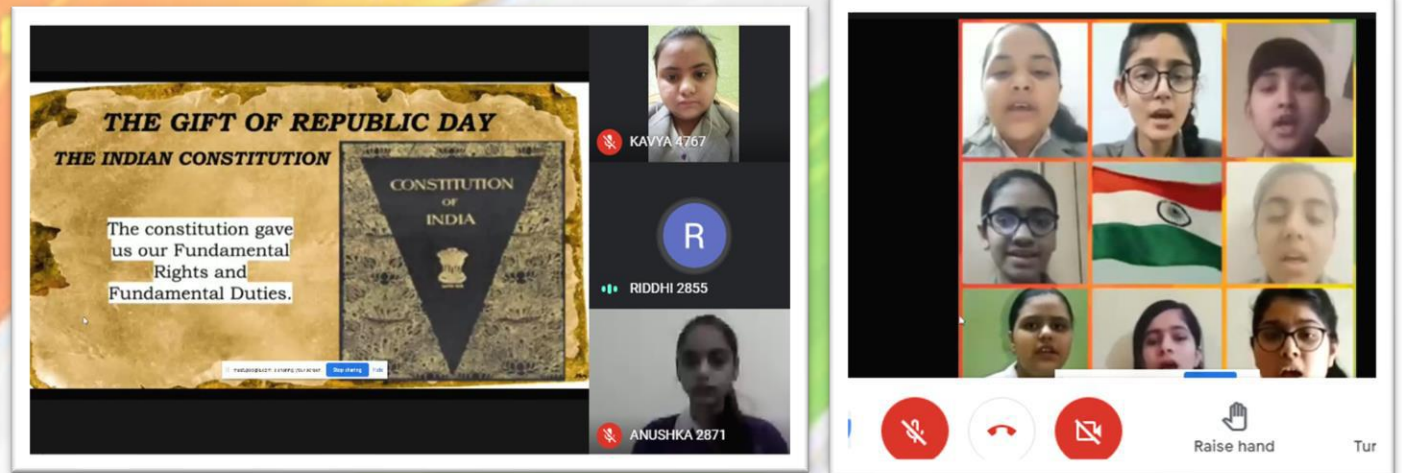
