## Indefinite Articles

> ' $A$ ' and ' $a n$ ' are called indefinite articles because they do not refer to any particular noun.
We use indefinite articles before a singular countable noun.
NOTE: We do not use 'a' or 'an' with uncountable nouns. For example,

- a milk X
- a water X
- a snow X

We use a or an when we talk about a common noun for the first time.
We use $\underline{\boldsymbol{a}}$ where the noun is singular and begins with a consonant sound.
Examples: a parrot, a bag, a girl, a cake
We use an when the noun is singular and begins with a vowel sound.
Examples: an elephant, an owl, an old house, an orange

$>$ The definite article is used before both singular and plural nouns.
$>$ We use the before nouns starting with consonants as well as vowels.

- When we talk about something in particular.

Full stops, commas and question marks are marks of punctuation that are used in a sentence or a paragraph.
$>$ We put a FULL STOP (.) at the end of a sentence.
$>$ We put a QUESTION MARK (?) at the end of a sentence where something is been asked or inquired.
$>$ When we give a list of words in a sentence, we use a COMMA (,) between the words. We use a comma to separate the words in a sentence.

In a sentence, lists of names or other items, if more than two in number, are separated by a comma. The last item in the list is separated from the previous one by and. For example, I bought textbooks, notebooks, pens, pencils and erasers.

When the written text is part of a conversation, a comma separates the rest of the sentence from the name or designation of the person. For example, Please excuse me, Sir.
